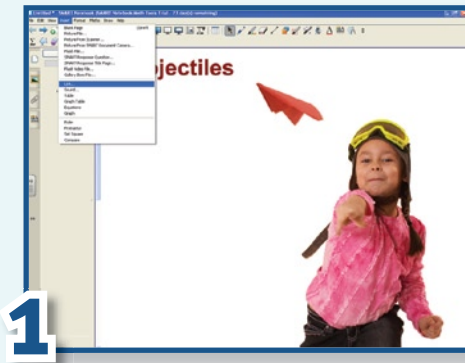


Partnering SMART Notebook with Boardworks will help you make the best use of your classroom technology and teach inspirational classes. Here's how:

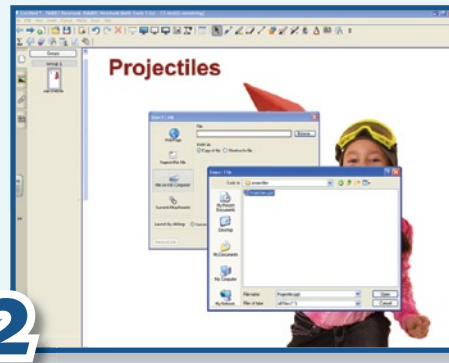
## Linking to a Boardworks presentation

Boardworks presentations can be easily linked to a page in your SMART Notebook. Just follow these simple steps:



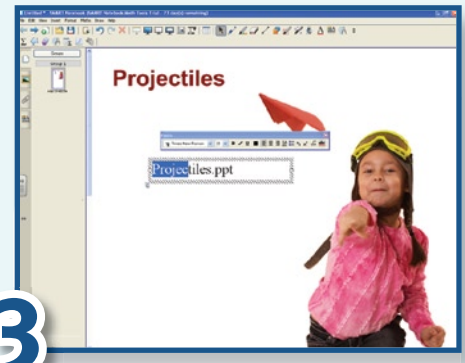

Click on **Insert > Link**.

Click on the **'File on this Computer'** tab and navigate to the Boardworks presentation you want to link to. You can choose whether you want to insert a link to this file or instead to include the actual file within the presentation. You can also set how it displays.

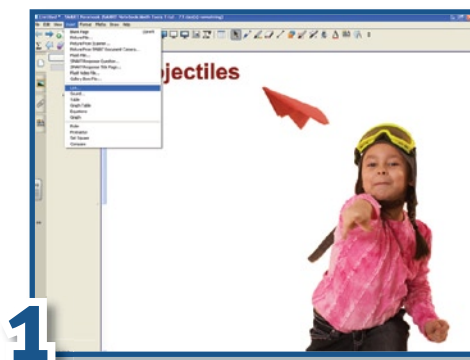

Your link will appear on your notebook page. You can rename, resize, rotate or move this to where you want it. Pressing on this icon will instantly launch the Boardworks presentation in slideshow mode.

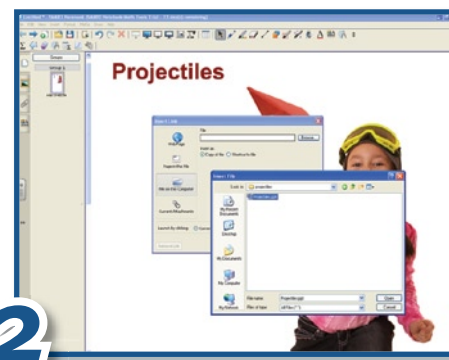
## Using Ink Notes with Boardworks presentations

When you use Boardworks presentations with your SMART software PowerPoint gains extra tools. You can use these tools to make annotations to Boardworks presentation slides which can then be added to your SMART Notebook. Just follow these simple steps:

Open your chosen Boardworks presentation and use the SMART board tools to make your annotations. When you are done, press the **'Save Ink Notes'** button.

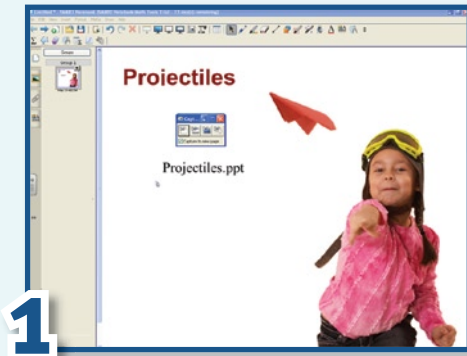

The slide will automatically be added as a page to your SMART Notebook.

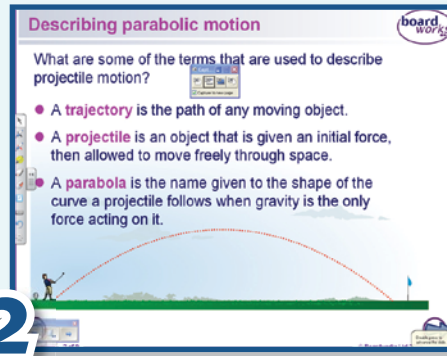
## Inserting images of slides from Boardworks presentations

You can use the Capture tool to insert whole images or parts of images from Boardworks slides into your SMART notebook presentations. Just follow these simple steps:



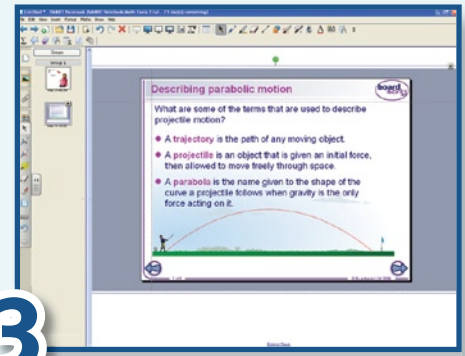

Press on the **'Screen Capture'** button in SMART Notebook. A pop-up box of screen capture buttons should appear.

Open your chosen Boardworks presentation in slideshow mode and press on the capture button to capture the image of the slide you want.

The image of the slide will automatically appear in your SMART Notepad as a new page.
