THE CHALLENGE

Boardworks is designed for ease of use and to be implemented quickly and efficiently, simplifying curriculum supplementation for Chacon-Kedge and the districts she supports. Brian Moffett, a Special Education Teacher with Jemez Mountain in the Northwest REC, notes that "before Boardworks, we had a hodgepodge of resources that were all over the place. One of the major challenges faced by Chacon-Kedge's team is the frequent change in leadership at the district level. Existing connections are broken and new ones aren't always made, resulting in gaps that can create additional challenges for special education teachers.

THE SOLUTION

The goal of Chacon-Kedge and the Northwest REC is to support capacity-building activities within the schools among special education staff and staff that work directly with kids who have disabilities. "Part of that work includes taking stock of the number of different platforms and subscriptions that we offer, all the things that we purchased for the districts, including, but not limited to things like the student management system, resources, and platforms that lend support for the day to day activities that teachers engage in, providing instruction and literacy support for their students."
